RULE 7-2-2

Rule 7 Snapping, Handling and Passing the Ball

SECTION 2 FORMATION/POSITION, NUMBERING AND ACTION AT THE SNAP

ART. 2 . . . The players on **each side of** and **next to the snapper** **may lock legs with the snapper**, but any other A lineman must have each foot outside the closest foot of the player next to him at the snap. A's players may stand, crouch or kneel.

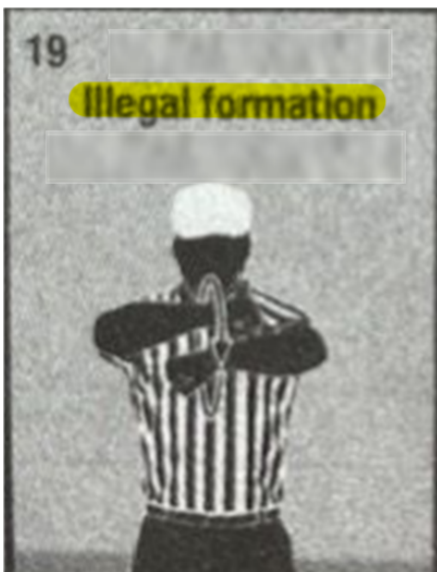

Rule 9 Conduct of Players and Others

SECTION 2 ILLEGAL USE OF HANDS AND HOLDING

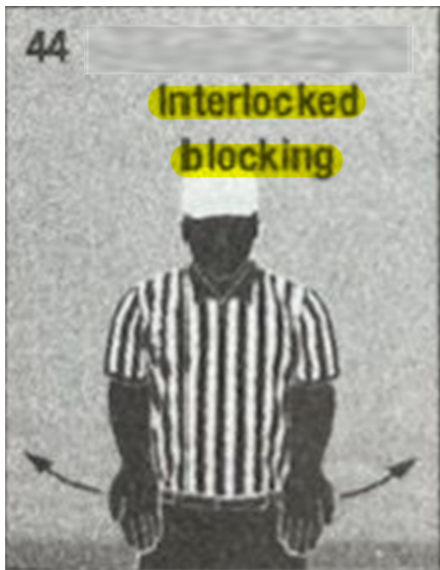
ART. 1 . . . An offensive player (except the runner) shall not:

b. Grasp or encircle any teammate to form interlocked blocking.

10 Yard Penalty

Receiving Team **Players** - the **Wedge**

THE WEDGE : On **free kick down** , the wedge is referred to **three or more** receiving team members who intentionally form a wedge for the purpose of blocking for the ball carrier.



Wedge Formation

Wedge Formation

It is **legal** to block from a wedge formation during any down.

It is **illegal** for three or more members of the receiving team to intentionally form a wedge for the purpose of blocking for the ball carrier after the ball has been kicked, except when the kick is from an obvious onside kick formation.

Play 1) "You Make the Call"

After a successful 3-point **FIELD GOAL**?



Team A kicks a **successful 3-point field goal** half way in the first quarter. There are no fouls on or after the kick. Which **team must kickoff** (free kick) at their own 40 yard after the score?



Decide the correct answer?

Choices

- A) Team A - the scoring team - will free kick from the A-40
- B.) Team B - the opponents - will free kick from the B-40
- C.) Team A designates who may kick off after a successful FG.
- D.) Team B designates who may kick off after a successful FG.
- E.) None of the above.

ANSWER

- D.)** Team B designates who may kick off after a successful FG.

Most of the time, the Team A - the scoring team will kickoff from the A-40 after a successful FG, since Team B wants the ball so they too can go on offense and possibly score.

However, following a successful field goal, **the opponents of the team which scored designates which team shall kick off**, except of course in overtime.

Rule 4-1-1 & 8-4-2

Play 2) "You Make the Call"

After a successful 1-point or 2-point **TRY**?



Team A scores a **1-point** or **2-point try** half way in the first quarter. There are no fouls on or after the kick. Which **team must kickoff** (free kick) at their own 40 yard after the score?



Decide the correct answer?
(Think, Turn & Talk for 2 minutes)



Choices

- A) Team A - the scoring team - will free kick from the A-40
- B.) Team B - the opponents - will free kick from the B-40
- C.) Team A designates who may kick off after a successful FG.
- D.) Team B designates who may kick off after a successful FG.
- E.) None of the above.

ANSWER

D.) Team B designates who may kick off after a Try.

Most of the time, the Team A - the scoring team will kick off from the A-40 after a **successful** or **unsuccessful** try, since Team B wants the ball, so they too can go on offense and possibly score.

However, following a try, **the opponents of the team which scored designates which team shall kick off**, except of course in overtime.

Rule 8-3-2

Play 3) "You Make the Call"

A fumble during a **TRY?**



On a **TRY**, A10 fumbles the ball is nearly at rest at the B-2 when B10 muffs the ball into B's end zone where B12 recovers and is immediately downed.



Decide the correct answer?

Choices

- A) The ball is dead as soon as A10 fumbled; try is over.
- B) The ball is dead as soon as B12 gains possession
- C) Team A scores a 1-point safety.
- D) Team B scores a 1-point safety.
- E) Answers B & C are both correct.
- F) Answers B & D are both correct.

ANSWER

E) Answers B & C are both correct.

B) The ball is dead as soon as B12 gains possession

C) Team A scores a 1-point safety.

The ball remained alive when A-10 fumbled, a bean bag was thrown.

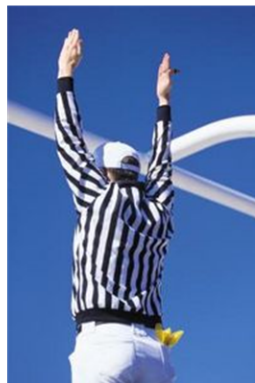
B-10's muff was a new "force" that put the ball into his own end zone.

Ball became dead in Team B's end zone. Team B put the ball there.

That is a safety. Since the safety is during a TRY it is only a 1-point safety. **Team A** scores, or is awarded, a **1-point safety**.
